Proposed By Law Changes

Vote To Take Place April 3rd 2024 at the regular Lodge Meeting.

Change to Article 5 Elective Officers and Duties (Change to the last sentence in the Treasure and Secretary description) to: For the faithful performance of his duties, he shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of \$5,000.00 per annum, payable monthly.

Change to Article 6 Appointive Positions and Duties (Section 4. Of the Tiler the last sentence) to: For the faithful performance of doing his duties, he shall receive as compensation for his services the current years dues per annum, payable annually.

Addition to No. 1 Rule: Stewards are in control of the lodge and enforcement of all House Committee Rules and are not allowed to consume alcohol while on duty.

Change to No. 6 Rule: No Person under the age of 18 will be allowed into the Members Lounge at any time (exceptions - all family events and special days i.e., Town Day, all minors must be out by 6:30pm).
